Description: The practicum student will work with the Education and Outreach Department of the Sexual Assault Resource Center to develop age-appropriate primary prevention curriculum for children in grades K-12th focused on topics related to body safety, healthy relationships, interpersonal violence prevention, consent, and sexual assault intervention and prevention. This student will review current organization curriculum, develop a list of needed lessons, research and review available educational resources, and develop three lessons for organization's primary prevention curriculum. The practicum student will attend and participate in presentations of these lessons at local schools and adjust their structure or content based on the lesson's performance with students.

Expectations:

- 3) Develop either (1) three lessons on separate topics or (2) 3 lessons on the same topic for different age groups.
- 4) Attend and participate in trial runs of lessons
- 5) Adjust lessons as needed based on trial runs.
